Sailing Instructions

Item 1 - Replace item 14 Courses with the following:

14. Courses

- 14.1. The morning races (1 to 3) will sail two rounds of their course. Race 1 will sail the Short Course as shown in the course diagram. Races 2 and 3 will sail the Standard Course.
- 14.2. Races 4 to 10 Only: Two rounds of the Cruiser Course as shown in the course diagram.
- 14.3. Race 11: Three rounds of the Short Course as shown in the course diagram.
- 14.4. Races 12, 13 and 14 Only: Three rounds of the Standard Course as shown in the course diagram.

Item 2 – Insert the following:

16.3 Shortening Course In accordance with RRS 32.2 Competitors are reminded that if the race committee signals a shortened course as per 16.2, the finishing line shall be,

- (a) at a rounding mark, between the mark and a staff displaying flag S or
- (b) at a line boats are required to cross at the end of each lap.

The shortened course shall be signalled before the first boat crosses the finishing line.

Item 3 - Course Diagram

The notation for the Short Course should read “PY 1240 and above”
